Corner of Section 36 T. 33 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B. & M. bears S. 76°34'00" E., at 7,480 feet; and ALSO Point of Diversion 6, located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 35 T. 33 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the S. E. Corner of said Section 36 bears S. 79°37'00" E., at 7,625 feet.

(19) The character of the soil is sandy loam (Sandy, gravelly, loam). A continuous flow of 16.87 cubic feet of water per second has been used to irrigate 562.54 acres of land and 2812.7 acre-feet per acre per annum have been used to irrigate the crops.

(20) Remarks: Water is comingled with water from Sharps Creek and Poet Creek.


