THE WATER WAS FIRST PUT TO BENEFICIAL USE PRIOR TO 1867 BY J.C. BUTLER. ABSTRACT OF TITLE AND COPIES OF ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS SUPPORTING THIS PROOF ARE ATTACHED TO THIS FILING AS SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION.
