

To Whom it May Concern:

I, DeLyle "Bud" Danner, was Supervising Water Commissioner for the Division of Water Resources, which the Humboldt Water Distribution District is part thereof, from 1963 until 1981. From 1957 to 1962, I was Assistant Supervising Water Commissioner and from 1952 to 1956, I was a Water Commissioner on the Humboldt River. During the period from 1948 to 1962, George W. Hennen was in charge of the Humboldt River, and was assistant in 1947. A.J. Millar (Archie Millar) was Supervising Water Commissioner from 1935 to 1947.

There was a well, which I remember, that was located 300 or so feet east of the Upper Licking Ditch. The ditch comes out on the east side of the Upper Licking Dam in the Humboldt River and runs north. This is not the dam or ditch that comes out in the Lovelock property and brings water from the Humboldt River to the old Rock Creek channel. This well was pumped without restrictions, at times, in the dry years during my control and also Mr. Hennen's time. I was told by George W. Hennen that it was vested. I do recall that George told me that Archie Millar had told him that it had a vested right. I also remember, on several occasions, of talking with Earl Licking about the irrigation, stockwater, and other observation wells. Mr. Licking was conducting some kind of study about the underground water within the area. He also stated to me that his irrigation and stockwater wells on the ranch, as well as the wells, creeks, and springs he was using on the range, were vested.

I freely and willingly submit this information as a matter of public record.
