The watering was conducted during each of the following months year round. Sheep grazing on this winter range took place from early Autumn to late Spring (exact periods depended on climatic factors and range conditions). A small number of local stock was watered year-round.

(10) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

Within the general vicinity, bands of 2,000 or more sheep grazed the area tended by a shepherd with a burro or two. Bands grazed the area each season, watering at various springs.

(11) The amount of water which has been necessary to be diverted for this purpose has been

0.02 cubic feet per second.
448.83 gallons per minute equals 1 cubic foot per second.

(12) The works are located at within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 24, T20N, R23E, MDM
