(18) Water from the source given and through the works described is also used for the following purposes other than irrigation: Stockwatering and domestic

(19) The character of the soil is loam. A continuous flow of 2 1/2 cubic feet of water per second has been used to irrigate 100 acres of land and four acre-feet per acre per annum have been used to irrigate the crops.

(20) Remarks: Use Map #2. Stockwater and Domestic are used year around.

The undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by Peter Jackson are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief the undersigned deponent is acting as agent for the claimant

If proof is not made by claimant, deponent should state on this line by virtue of what authority he represents the claimant


