The watering was conducted during each of the following months April 1st thru October 31st

The State Water Engineer, under the Stock Watering Act (Chapter 201, statues of 1925), accepted range claim maps upon which livestockmen depicted the area of range customarily used in their operation. John M. Marble and Robert E. Marble, predecessors, filed map 659-34, which included this area. They were, in turn, successors to the Union Land and Cattle Company, which were successors to the Nevada Land and Cattle Company, which were successors to the Marys River Land and Cattle Company, which was owned by N.H.A. Mason and Lewis L. Bradley. The Marys River Land and Cattle Company owned much of the private land in the drainage and for that reason, made grazing use of this area. In 1903, tax rolls of Elko County, Nevada, indicated this company owned 3,500 stock cattle and 240 horses; and in 1904, 3,000 stock cattle, 240 horses and 4,800 sheep. Therefore, it is on these basic facts that a 1904 vested water right is claimed within this drainage area.

(10) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant in subsequent years was as follows: 4,000 head for one month or 2,000 head for two months or 800 head of five months.  
If water was not used, or used in reduced quantity at any time, full information as to causes and duration of non-use should be given.

(11) The amount of water which has been necessary to be diverted for this purpose has been 0.0247 cubic feet per second.  
448.83 gallons per minute equals 1 cubic foot per second.

(12) The works are located at N½NE¼ Section 34, T. 42 N., R. 58 E., MDM.  
Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision, section, township and range of public survey. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.


