(19) The character of the soil is sandy loam A continuous flow of 1.6 cubic feet of water per second has been used to irrigate 40.2 acres of land and 2.1 to 6.2 acre-feet per acre per annum have been used to irrigate the crops.

(20) Remarks..... The Simon's, together with their neighbors, as successors in interest to W.F. Dressler have continued to utilize one-half of the flow from Sheridan Creek to irrigate their property. As the flow within Sheridan Creek varies in any given year the amount of water available for usage varies accordingly. Waters from Sheridan Creek are commingled with water from Barber Creek to irrigate the subject properties. Rights from Barber Creek have been previously adjudicated and are of Record dated May 27, 1921.




