(1) Name of claimant United States of America - Forest Service

(2) Source of water Angel Creek and tributaries

(3) The water is diverted by natural channel

(4) The water is diverted at the following point(s) NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 35, T. 36 N, R 61 E, MDB&M
(unsurveyed) or at a point from which the SW section corner Sec. 35, T. 36 N, R 61 E
bears S 31° 30' W at a distance of 5000 feet

(5) The water is impounded in natural channel

(6) The construction of the ditch or other works was begun Prior to 1900
and completed prior to 1900

(7) The nature of the claimant's title to the land upon which the source of water and place of use
are located is land acquired by the United States of America in 1848 and
subsequently reserved from the public domain for National Forest purposes
since May 3, 1906.

(8) The claimant's water right was (was not) recorded in the office of the County Recorder of
County, at Page of Book of

(9) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant during the first year ^{Date} 1881, was 15 cattle 15 horses sheep or Other. The watering was conducted during each of the following months March through October

(10) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

While numbers of livestock and season of use have varied, use has been continuous since 1881. If water was not used, or used in reduced quantity at any time, full information as to causes and duration of non-use should be given.

1882 - 1885 14 cattle, 18 horses

1886 - 1896 50 cattle, 25 horses

1897 - 1910 150 cattle, 40 horses

1910 - 1931 70 cattle, 30 horses

1932 - 1978 70 cattle, 30 horses

1979 to present 41 cattle

(11) The amount of water which has been necessary to be diverted for this purpose has been .015 cubic feet per second, or sufficient to water the permitted livestock 448.83 gal. per min. equals 1 cubic foot per second.

(12) The works are located at NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 35, T. 36 N., R. 61 E., Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision, section, township and range of public survey. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated. MDB&M (unsurveyed) and then upstream to the headwaters of Angel Creek and its tributaries.
