

(19) The character of the soil is sandy (Sandy, gravelly, loam). A continuous flow of 1 1/2 cubic feet of water per second has been used to irrigate 26.5 acres of land and 64.5 acre-feet per acre per annum have been used to irrigate the crops. 8/14/96 12.9 132.5



(20) Remarks. Claim of vested right is based upon the statements of claimant Willard H. George for Application for Permit #9038, on which he claimed that the water had been used for 35 years by the previous owner, who constructed the works. Mr. George filed his claim in 1929. He also states that he will file a cultural map to show beneficial use of the water in the past. The map was filed September 3, 1929 under permit #9038.


