(19) The character of the soil is sandy A continuous flow of 4 cubic feet of water per second has been used to irrigate 261.6 acres of land and 5 acre-feet per acre per annum have been used to irrigate the crops.

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(20) Remarks Well No. 1 and the three springs in this area provided water for irrigation, municipal, domestic, and stock uses for the Las Vegas Meadows in the early 1800s. Well No. 1 was artesian with flow joining spring discharges which naturally flowed toward the center of the Las Vegas Valley. In 1905 a pipeline was installed to intercept this water and carry it to the Las Vegas townsite. Well No. 1 was covered under Permits 7201 and 7202 issued by the Nevada State Engineer. The irrigated acreage is shown on the accompanying water right map for the transfer of water from Permit 7202 (copy attached).

The undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by Las Vegas Valley Water District are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

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

- No. 4 The channel was natural (prehistoric) carrying spring flow. in 1881, Stewart took possession from Gass and continued to irrigate. Facilities were first surveyed in 1904 and the first pipeline was laid in 1905. These springs and well were the source of water (municipal, irrigation, domestic, and stock) for the Las Vegas townsite.

- No. 10 Certified deeds are attached from Stewart to Clark and Clark to San Pedro, Los Angeles and Salt Lake Railroad Company. Las Vegas Land and Water was a subsidiary of the Railroad. The title from Las Vegas Land and Water to the Las Vegas Valley Water District is attached.

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
