(20) Remarks. Please use maps filed under 02856 and 24918 - Claimant is also the owner of a portion of 02856; 24918 and 24919 (see letter from DWR - Dick Clyde to Ronald L. Margiot dated April 6, 1993.)

Point of Diversion for return flows claimed is as shown on map filed under 02856, from Unnamed Spring (B) under 02857, and Luther Creek Point of Diversion in Section 35 under 02858.

A portion of the flow from Unnamed Spring (A) is carried to the place of use in a 2-inch diameter pipeline and a portion of the flow from Unnamed Spring (A) is carried in a 6-inch pipeline to a 6-inch valve and tee, which can discharge to the Unnamed Creek channel, all of which is shown on the map filed to support Permit 24918 and 24919.

The undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by Groenendyke Family Trust Dated March 2, 1978 are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.


