(3) Spring area contained by a masonry dam with a membrane water stop and gravel backfill feeding two 2" pipes, one to a yard hydrant and the second through a valve box to a lined pond. The pond feeds watering troughs for cattle and other wildlife including deer, antelope, and birds.

(9) Initially grazing occurred on a year-round basis. More recently, Bureau of Land Management (BLM) allotment plans have limited grazing during portions of the year. The current grazing permit allows for grazing from April 1st through October 15th. Claimants have a lease with the grazing permittee and provide water troughs available to cattle and wildlife on a year-round basis.

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
