(20) Remarks... commenced in 1898 with the discovery, recording and mining

on the Blossom, Coyote (& others) by Frank Perew, who was to become
Manager of the SOUTHERN NEVADA MINING & MILLING COMPANY in 1901 (ownership
of Blossom, Coyote, Julia T. (later to become John & Sanford Lode), Dabu
Whist, Diamond and California Fraction.) SNM&M was founded, financed and
administratively managed by William S. Shuler in 1901. Later in 1906
William S. Shuler purchased the Blossom, Coyote, Julia T. (later to
become the John & Sanford Lode), Diamond, Dabu, Whist). All the general
underground use of water was obtained from the Coyote Lodes' East Incline
Shaft and was used for domestic purposes and for the mining and milling
which occurred on the Blossom Lode. The SHULERS' use of water was well
established prior to the NV. State Law of March 22, 1913 which governs
the use of "underground water".

The Properties currently owned by SHULERS' are the COYOTE LODE, JOHN &
SANFORD LODE (formerly Julia T.) and the Whist Lode of the original
package of Properties owned in 1901 by SNM&M. HOWEVER, ALL WATER
servicing the subject Properties in 1901 and currently are obtained
from sources of the Coyote Lode's East Incline Shaft as obtained in
the early 1900's.

It is requested that the total 36,400,000 gals. listed in the original
2001 Appl. for Vested Water Rights be increased to 88,525,200 gals./yr.
The increase in gallonage has occurred due to extensive research of the
Shuler archives and can be justified by the data accompanying this appl.


