Because of the natural meadows in field it is difficult to determine actual usage.


(20) Remarks..... Shoshone meadows is primarily a natural meadow with a seasonal stream running up to July on a good year. The stream naturally spreads out as it hits the meadow and raises up the water table producing much grass on a big water year stream flow can be up to 2 c.f.s. for 3 months.
