

REMARKS

This Proof is associated with improved ranch property which has vested and adjudicated water rights on the Humboldt River for irrigation, livestock and domestic use under Proof 00223 & 00225 and is for the purpose of evidencing use of water for stock purposes within the open range area as provided under NRS 533.492 and 533.493.

The basis of this claim is presented in the affidavit of Walter I. Leberski which is attached.

In the original grazing application of W.H. Blair to the Taylor Grazing Service he stated the ranch normally ran 400 head of range stock for a nine month period. However, he applied for 220 cattle and 30 head of horses on that application dated May 4, 1935. A sale of the ranch operation by Henry F. Ebert, et ux, to Charles S. Walker also had a Bill of Sale for 210 head of cattle and 25 horses. The license issued by Grazing Service in 1950 was for 220 cattle and 10 horses. The Bill of Sale referred to above, the original application of 1935 and the license of 1950 evidence a normal number of stock using the open range at 250 head and that is the number claimed on this source.

The period of use is between March 1 and December 31 of each year. Due to past practices of movement of livestock and present allotment management plans, the stock use other sources than the subject of this Proof during the grazing season. However, the total of 250 head make use of the source for at least a portion of the period of use.

W.H. Blair claims use upon the area of this source in 1876 which may be correct. However, predecessors to the claimant first acquired land by a patent from the State of Nevada in 1879. Therefore, a priority of 1879 is claimed.
