The watering was conducted during each of the following months Jan 1 – Dec 31 of each year.

Records indicate that from 1865 to 1901 the property was owned by D.H. Dillard and the animal count for stockwatering fluctuated with as many as 150 head of cattle and 100 head of horses to as low as 2 head of cattle and 2 head of horses. There were also mules, sheep, hogs and a jackass.

(10) The approximate number of animals watered by the claimant in subsequent years was as follows:

Currently the wells provide stockwatering for as many as 2,500 head of horses and 1,500 head of cattle. The operation of the feedlot consists of a Feed Mill with a boiler and washing equipment, shop building for housing sick animals with sinks and spickets, and the use of water for grinding hay and dust control on pens.

If water was not used, or used in reduced quantity at any time, full information as to causes and duration of non-use should be given.

(11) The amount of water which has been necessary to be diverted for this purpose has been

.05 cubic feet per second.

- Two (2) well log reports were filed with N.D.W.R. for stockwatering but there are no permits associated with these wells, log numbers 1391 and 16037, attached.
- Appraisal Report of The Nevada Cattle Feeding Company, Inc. dated August 13, 1979
