My Grandfather, David Samuel Eldridge came to White Pine County in 1889, from Southern Utah. He settled on Silver Creek and lived there for two years. He moved from Silver Creek to Miller Wash.

He married Alice Lees at Osceola on June 6th, 1896. Together they raised 11 children at the Miller Wash Property. The oldest son, George H. Eldridge was born August 11, 1897.

The Miller Wash property and water have been used for domestic, livestock and farming by my family from about 1890, when my Grandfather David Samuel Eldridge settled to the present.

I have enclosed a marriage certificate dated 1896 and two birth certificates dated 1903 and 1905.
