Remarks

The Mustang Springs area was first developed and/or used in the late 1880's to serve ranchers and miners in the area associated with livestock grazing animals belonging to predecessors of the Claimant. Rawhide Ranch owns deeded land in Dunlap Canyon and at Tule Spring (also called Pacific Spring). The Pilot-Table Mountain Grazing Allotment (See attached map) is a water based grazing allotment.

The undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by David G. and/or Jackie A. Holmgren are full and correct to the best of his/her knowledge and belief.






