

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## ATTACHMENT

This claim is made under NRS 533.492 and NRS 533.493 which allows for recognition of a right to water range livestock within a basin where rights have been adjudicated. As this claim is within the adjudicated Humboldt River Basin it is based upon a subsisting right with a priority prior to 1905. The claim does not represent an additional water demand, over that allowed in the Humboldt River Decree but identifies the source, location and numbers of livestock.


Total water consumption by livestock within the grazing area of the claimant is not additive from all sources and is limited by 2,500 head of cattle using all water sources within the grazing area of the claimant.

The major predecessor of the claimant as to owned range lands is Hunter-Banks Company and that company's median priority from the Humboldt River Decree is 1886. This year of priority substantially agrees with the Tabulation Sheet as reviewed in the affidavit of Walter I. Leberski attached to the claim and therefore the year of 1886 becomes the priority.

Attached is an allotment map depicting the area of use of the claimant upon the public land and the source of this claim is within that area.

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
# Lone Mountain Allotment
