 1) Prior to 1879 until 1923: Cattle 1-2000 head, Horses 50, and Sheep 2000 by JR Benton, TJ Bell, George Dieringer, OC Warner, G Keough, BH Donnelley, et. all; 2) 1923-1945: 2-6000 angora goats by TO McKinnon; 3) 1945-1976: 1-2000 Cattle, 30 Horses, 2000 Sheep by Magnusen, Carpenter, Stinson, Brown, Elsner; 4) 1976-Present: Elsner, McKay, Estill, Holmgren: 1000 cattle and 12-30 horses. Livestock numbers varied year to year. Cattle year round from 1879, with sheep after 1910, and 2-6,000 angora goats 1923-1942; Sheep and cattle until 1976, since 1976 all cattle

Remarks

Water from the Corral Spring area flows or seeps in a natural stream for approximately 500 feet more or less, on public domain. The natural flow from Corral Spring has been continuously used by Claimant's and predecessor stock owners prior to 1879. A pipe line and trough and corral was installed at some point after 1879. JR Benton made the first claim on Corral Spring in 1879, calling it Benton's Spring (Esmeralda Co Records, Gillis Mountain, Book A, Pg 47) claiming it as a spring and or series of springs for agricultural stock or other purposes with the right to divert the water for these purposes.

The undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by David G. and Jackie A. Holmgren are full and correct to the best of his/her knowledge and belief.





