Remarks

Warren W. Williams was located in Edwards Creek Valley prior to 1878. His house/ranch was located on the E 1/2 of SE, Section 5, T19N R37E, MDBM, and named on the General Land Office Survey Map, approved 11/28/1879. Assessor's records of 1883 state W.W. Williams had 4,000 head of sheep.

App. 5840 called this Hole-in-the-Wall #2 incorrectly.

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The undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by \_\_\_\_\_ are full and correct to the best of his/her knowledge and belief.
