the granting of application number 11236, filed on  
Jan. 25,, 1945 by J. H. Frasher, 236 N. Virginia St., Reno, Nev.  
to appropriate the waters of Underground  
situated in Lander County, State of Nevada, for the  
following reasons and on the following grounds, to wit:

Application of said J. H. Frasher covers well now owned by Mill Gulch Placer Mining Co. and is covered by certificate No. 2599, subject of permit No. 10071 and said water is used on mining claims owned by said Mill Gulch Placer Mining Co. Said claims being held under existing exemption laws.

WHEREFORE protestant prays that the application  
be Denied on the grounds that the water from this well is fully appropriated.  
(Denied, or issued subject to prior rights, as the case may be)

and that the use of water herein claimed by protestant be confirmed  
and that an order be entered establishing said right and for such  
other relief as the State Engineer deems just and proper.
