THE WATERS OF Public Waters of

Comes now Leo K. Stewart, President of Alamo Irrigation Company Inc.
whose post-office address is Alamo, Nevada
whose occupation is Ranching, and protests
the granting of application number 22038, filed on
11th of June, 1964 by U. S. A. Bureau of Sports Fisheries & Wildlife
to appropriate the waters of State of Nevada, Pah. Lakes and Tributaries
situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada, for the
following reasons and on the following grounds, to wit:

That if previous applications now pending for agricultural purposes in the Pahrnagat
Lakes Area are satisfied there will be no water available for such applications.
Also would place in jeopardy at present approved appropriation of the Alamo
Irrigation Company Inc.

WHEREFORE protestant prays that the application

be Denied, subject to prior rights
(Denied, or issued subject to prior rights, as the case may be)

and that the use of water herein claimed by protestant be confirmed
and that an order be entered establishing said right and for such
other relief as the State Engineer deems just and proper.
