Lincoln County, State of Nevada, for the following reasons and on the following grounds to wit:

The change of use from irrigation is not necessary. The traditional use of the reservoir is for irrigation which also serves wildlife by it's very existence. Also the proposed change may cause economic hardship on the residents and other users of the water in that area due to a proposed recovery plan which has been vigorously opposed by the entire group of water rights holders and users. The proposed changes allows the Fish and Wildlife Service to continue to ignore economic, custom and culture concerns that the residents of this valley have raised to the service. The current uses allow for multiple uses which better serves all public uses.

THEREFORE the Protestant requests that the application be Denied

Denied, issued subject to prior rights, etc., as the case may be

and that an order be entered for such as relief as the State Engineer deems just and proper.
