

Grounds for Protesting

Application 64670

1. The 2200 acres described under the proposed place of use of application 64670 is BLM land and the Protestant has grazing rights on this land under the authority of Sunnyside BLM grazing allotment No. 01023.
2. The applicant does not own the property nor have access to the land therefore the applicant will be unable to place the water to use.
3. The Protestant has several recorded and unrecorded vested rights for surface water within the Cave Valley area that may be irrefutably harmed by the issuance of this permit.
4. The approval of application 64670 would adversely effect the Protestants existing cattle operation and livelihood.
5. The application is speculative in nature and the finally disposition of the water is questionable.
