PROTEST

Comes now The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe of Indians, whose post office address is P.O. Box 256, Nixon, Nevada 89424, whose occupation is a federally recognized Tribe of Indians, the governing body of the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation, organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, with a Constitution and By-laws approved by the Secretary of Interior, and protests the granting of Application Number 68807, filed on May 13, 2002 by High Rock Holdings, to appropriate underground waters of the State of Nevada situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada, for the following reasons and on the following grounds, to wit:

1. Granting the application would threaten to prove detrimental to the public interest.
2. Granting the application would conflict with the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe's reserved and other water rights, including the right to use the groundwater underlying the Smoke Creek portion of the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation.
3. Granting the application would conflict with other existing rights.
4. There is no remaining unappropriated water in Smoke Creek Desert Basin.
