



### Protest Grounds

**The proposed cost of works of this application exceeds one billion dollars. The State Engineer must consider whether the applicant has the financial capability to place the water to beneficial use.**

**Similar applications to appropriate 27, 627 cfs from the Spencer River were denied by the State Engineer's Office (ruling 4692) because the applicant failed to provide sufficient information to guard the public interest or prove that there were sufficient funds to place the water to beneficial use. The same grounds exist to deny Application 69879.**

**There is no water available to appropriate from the requested source and granting the appropriation requested by this application would interfere with existing rights, and the development of the resource would be detrimental to the public interest. Lincoln County and Southern Nevada Water Authority entered into an agreement on file at the State Engineer's Office for the development of water resources in the basins from which the applicant has requested water. The applications described in the agreement have seniority over the applicant's.**
