





Applications 73048 & 73049

The above referenced applications propose to appropriate 1,000.00 acre-feet of ground water from the Bedell Flat hydrographic basin. State Engineer's ruling # 5429 issued on October 14<sup>th</sup>, 2004 determined a total available duty of 144.20 acre-feet remains for appropriation by Application 66873. That ruling is currently under appeal and Washoe County is not aware of any new studies that could have affected the State Engineer's determination.

Therefore, based on the available information and the State Engineer's ruling # 5429, it is clear that there is no water available for appropriation, and the applications should be denied.
