NEVADA STATE ENGINEER RULING 5498, dated JULY 13, 2005, regarding the Dayton Valley Hydrographic Basin, states in its conclusions: "The State Engineer is prohibited by law from granting a permit under an application to change the public waters where B. the proposed use or change conflicts with protectable interests in existing domestic wells as set forth in NRS 533.024." This protest is being filed on behalf of over 30 Rancho Haven residents who are concerned that the exportation of water from the Red Rock Hydrographic will jeopardize existing domestic wells, and set a precedent for future exportation.

THEREFORE the Protestant requests that the application be DENIED


and that an order be entered for such relief as the State Engineer deems just and proper.
