

PROTEST



Comes now Bureau of Land Management whose post office address is 50 Bastian Road, Battle Mountain, Nevada, 89820 whose occupation is Land Management and protests the granting of Application Number 76768, filed on February 26, 2008 by DAVID L AND/OR LINDA K WOOLFOLK to appropriate the waters of CHERRY SPRING situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada, for the following reasons and on the following grounds, to wit:

- 1.) Application number 76768 is not in accord with 533.503 1 (a) (1) of the Nevada Revised Statutes. David and Linda Woolfolk do not possess a grazing permit in the Fish Creek Ranch Allotment to graze sheep.
- 2.) An authorization to construct a stock pond has not been issued by the BLM-Battle Mountain.
- 3.) Application number 76768 is applying for water use for the period 1/1 - 12/31. BLM-Battle Mountain believes this is excessive given the limited season of use associated with the Woolfolk's grazing permit; permitted season of use is 4/01 - 5/15.

THEREFORE the Protestant requests that the application be DENIED and that an order be entered for such relief as the State Engineer deems just and proper.
