This proposed water right application, is in effect, detrimental to all existing, prior rights. The adjudicated irrigators from Bishop Creek streams and tributaries, have historically been in short supply of needed waters. The State of Nevada Water Commissioners can attest there have been many ongoing problems with the limited waters available for many years, and is still continuing today.

Although applicants claim more water is flowing in one area, this only means that less water is flowing in another area of the tributary; hence, in truth, there is not more water being made. Thus, to protect existing water users this application needs to be denied.

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
