



**ATTACHMENT TO LOUIS BENEZET'S PROTESTS OF APPLICATIONS NO. 78239 AND 78240 FILED APRIL 10, 2009 BY LINCOLN COUNTY WATER DISTRICT AND VIDLER WATER COMPANY, INC.**

Lincoln County Water District and Vidler Water Company have filed applications No. 78239 and 78240 to appropriate ground water in Dry Lake Valley. The protestant, Louis Benezet, is a resident of Prince Mine in the adjacent hydrological basin who depends on spring water from the Highland Range, which is the divide between the valleys. The protestant would be significantly and adversely affected by the applicant's proposed appropriation. Therefore, Louis Benezet asks the State Engineer to deny Applications No. 78239 and 78240 on the following grounds:

The groundwater in Dry Lake Valley is fully appropriated. See ruling 5993.

Over appropriation of the groundwater in the valley would affect the interbasin flow to neighboring valleys and conflict with existing water rights in these valleys.

Over appropriation of groundwater would affect springs in Dry Lake and neighboring valleys. State and federal wildlife management areas in Pahrangat Valley could be affected.

These applications are speculative in nature. Vidler Water Company And Lincoln County Water District are seeking water for interbasin transfer south for sale for profit to developers for municipal and industrial use. They are attempting to acquire this water by pretending they need the water for local agricultural use. The State Engineer should deny Applications No. 78239 and 78240 on the grounds that they are not in good faith and speculative in violation of Nevada water law.
