Attachment to Protest by Lund Irrigation and Water Company

This application is approximately 50 miles due North of our carbonate springs in White River Valley. In our judgment, the quantity of water filed for in the six applications would obviously only be available from a carbonate source, and therefore could affect our carbonate springs.

Furthermore, we have not heard of, nor read, any plan to put the water requested in these applications to beneficial use at the location indicated in the Point of Use information. We believe this application to be speculative in nature.
