EXHIBIT A

To Protest of Truckee Meadows Water Authority to Application No. 82693

The Truckee Meadows Water Authority ("TMWA") conditionally protests the granting of Application No. 82693 because, on its face, it seeks to change the full decreed irrigation duty of a portion for Truckee River Decree Claim No. 601 to wildlife and instream use. It proposes to change the existing place of use to the Truckee River from the existing point of diversion at the Pioneer Ditch to and including Pyramid Lake.

Claim No. 601 has an irrigation duty of 4.0 acre feet per acre. In order to avoid a conflict with and injury to existing rights, the quantity of water changed must be limited to the consumptive use component, or 2.5 acre feet per acre, as the State Engineer has determined in connection with similar applications and in Nevada State Engineer Ruling No. 6035. The consumptive use limitation of 2.5 acre feet per acre equates to 136.88 acre feet at a diversion rate of 0.856 cubic feet per second. TMWA requests that the Application either be denied, or that, if approved, it be conditioned so that only the consumptive portion of the originally decreed water right may be changed to the new manner of use. The consumptive use portion available at the Pioneer Ditch should be limited to 2.5 acre feet per acre, or 136.88 acre feet at a diversion rate of 0.856 cubic feet per second, and the remainder of 82.12 acre feet at a diversion rate of 0.514 cubic feet per second should remain in the River and be available for downstream users.

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
