PROTEST

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that on the 27th day of September 2013 2008 Vlot Revocable Trust of Chowchilla, California made application to the State Engineer of Nevada for permission to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of 0.4859 c.f.s., a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 16628, Certificate 5317. Water will be diverted from an underground source at a point located within the SW1/4 NW1/4, Section 26, T12N, R23E, MDM or at a point from which the W1/4 corner of said Section 26 bears S 46 degrees 19 minutes 25 seconds W, a distance of 1,625.21 feet (approx. 3 miles E of Simpson, NV). Water will be used for commercial purposes from January 1st to December 31st of each year. The existing point of diversion was located within the SE1/4 NW1/4 of Section 36, T12N, R23E, MDM or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 36 bears N 49 degrees 24 minutes W, a distance of 2,489.2 feet. Water was used for irrigation purposes from April 1st to October 31st of each year.

I protest the conversion of this well from irrigation to commercial. The Nevada Division of Water Resources considers Smith Valley Dairy Farms to be a commercial business, and the amount of water from that well will be in excess of 1,200 AFA to supply only about one third of the water required to maintain a herd of 6,400 cows. Pumping that much more water from that well will adversely affect the aquifer, due in part by the severe drought in Nevada.

I protest the change in period of use from 04-1031 to 0101-1231, because the the period of non use is to allow the aquifer to be recharged. If the period of use is changed to annual, then the aquifer will be seriously depleted. This depletion of the aquifer will probably affect my domestic well, and may cause it to go dry.

I protest the change in the point of diversion to the Vlot Trust property located East of Hunewell Lane in Smith Valley, because the only way to get water to that property is to run a pipe line or drill a new well. I understand there is a moratorium on drilling a new Ag well or a commercial well in Nevada.


Please find the enclosed protest forms for well applications numbers; 83121, 83122, and 83123.

I own parcel #010-111-32 at 12 Linda Way in Smith Valley, NV and believe that these wells and the possible activities of VLOT Revocable Trust directly west of my property will adversely affect my domestic well water and property value in the future, therefore I request that these well applications for conversion from irrigation to commercial wells be denied until further information is available about the activities of VLOT.

I believe that the number of dairy cows they are proposing and the amount of water they require will adversely impact the other land owner's well water in the area.
