



**PROTEST**

I protest the conversion of this well use from irrigation to commercial.

The Application No. 83122 shows the request for 0 AFA and changing the period from *April 1st to November 1st* to *January 1st to December 31st*. There is no indication of the amount of water that they will need to support the Smith Valley Dairy Farms. This will be done on a future Permit which places us on a slippery slope because that Permit may not afford us the opportunity to protest or know the amount that will be requested.

I am very concerned since I know that Dairy's require an enormous amount of water for their cows as well as their daily operation and this will definitely effect our irrigation well located on 350 Burke Dr., Wellington, NV.

Our irrigation well has dropped 30 ft. this year. If we lose our water we will be out of business with our Crops and our Cattle We have owned our Ranch since 1989 and at that time we had quite a few Artesian wells which have dried up due to the drought in the last few years.

I have already experienced over pumping in Merced Ca. on our property at 4450 N Santa Fe Dr. Our well went dry last summer due to Merced Irrigation District turned on a backup pump and well about 1/4 mile from our well. Static water level was 80 ft. We had to drill a new well to 340 ft. This same situation could occur on our ranch here in Smith Valley because we already have underground water problems that we are presently trying to overcome.

I am requesting this permit request be denied because I can not be assured that approval would not lead to exacerbation of my existing water problems.
