ATTACHMENT TO PROTEST FORM FOR APPLICATION NUMBER 83123-

LYON COUNTY, STATE OF NEVADA, FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS AND ON THE FOLLOWING GROUNDS, TO WIT:

The proposed point of diversion is too close to our irrigation well (application # 18,804, certificated right #5967, dating from year 1960) which is permitted to pump 1,600 acre feet/year. Pumping from both wells simultaneously could cause a drop in the water level in our well. If the water level drops, we would have to put in a larger pump and motor to pump the same volume of water at our cost.

Our well is used primarily during drought years and is pumped less during years of average or better precipitation. This intermittent pumping allows for aquifer recharge during years of lower use. Because the applicant's Point Of Diversion is so close to our well and will be pumped year round, the ground water level will not fully recover under our well as it has for the last 53 years.

We request that the applicant move the Point Of Diversion further east and south closer to the original point of diversion so that the well is 2,500 feet from our irrigation well.
