

I protest the conversion of this well from stock watering to commercial, because the applicant will then apply for a great deal more acre feet of water than the 4.8 AFA currently permitted from that well in order to provide water for the dairy cows.

I protest the new point of diversion, which will allow Vlot Revocable Trust to use a great many more acre feet of water annually from this well on their property, located to the East of Hunewell Lane, to provide for the dairy herd.

I have been told that this well has not been used for many years. If true, then the permit has expired, and Vlot Revocable Trust would need to apply for a new permit, and increase the permitted water rights to exceed 144 AFA. I protest the granting of a new permit based on the drought conditions, and subsequent depletion of the aquifer, with no certainty that the aquifer will be recharged any time soon, if at all.
