



## Attachment "1"

The applicant must recognize the provisions of NRS 533.367 which states the following:

- 1.) Before a person may obtain a right to the use of water from a spring or water which has seeped to the surface of the ground, the person **must ensure** that wildlife which customarily uses the water **will have access to it.**  
The state Engineer may waive this requirement for domestic use.  
(underlining added)
- 2.) Wild horses are not considered "wildlife" therefore wild horses must be deleted from the application.
- 3.) The Applicant can file a separate application to appropriate water from the subject spring for wild horse watering subject to existing rights and unappropriated water available at the source.
- 4.) The BLM must get a wild horse management plan in place in order to balance the use of the habitat for the benefit of all uses including but not limited to wild horses.
