

Attachment to Protest of Water Application Number 83222

The Lund Irrigation and Water Company is in protest of the water application number 83222 for the following reasons.

We are uncertain as to what is meant by the reference to the White River Slough. Where does it start and where does it end? Our concern is with water that exists north of the Mormon Springs area. We are protesting this application to the extent that it relates to White River and its' tributaries north of Mormon Springs.

Is there any surplus or unappropriated water north of Mormon Springs? We call your attention to Application number 13479 dated May 2, 1951. Quoting from that application "this is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby deny the same, on grounds that the waters of the White River Slough are fully appropriated and that the granting of the application would impair the value of existing rights and would be detrimental to the public welfare."
