

and that an order be entered for such relief as the State Engineer deems just and proper.



ATTACHMENT 1

The Protestant of this Application owns several water rights in the neighboring Black Rock Desert Hydrographic basin and is concerned that a water withdrawal of the magnitude proposed under Application 84430 would eventually cause irreparable damage to their holdings. The proposed manner of use threatens to prove detrimental to the public interest (NRS 533.371 (6)). This Application seeks to appropriate water from Mud Meadows ground water basin and transfer it to other basins (interbasin transfer), approximately 100 airline miles to the south. The Applicant did not cite a specific "Project" for utilizing water for this Application. The Applicant is not an Entity authorized to divert water, nor does he have the wherewithal to construct a pipeline of sufficient size and length to move 7,000 acre-feet of water over the distance to the Proposed Place of Use. Please refer to NRS 533.370 1 (c), (1) and (2), 2 and 3 (a), (b), (c), (d) & (e). Under NRS 533.370 4 (h), the Applicant does not have authorized entry permission from governmental agencies to move water via pipeline across public lands. Because the Point of Diversion of Application 84430 lies within the Black Rock National Conservation area, special use permits may be required from the U. S. Bureau of Land Management or other governmental agencies before approval of this Application. All Statutes under NRS 533.364 must be strictly followed. In addition, if this Application is approved, it would be subject to all the provisions under NRS 533.438.

The approval of Application 84430 and subsequent pipeline building activities would cause irreparable damage to the Black Rock desert and its ecology.

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
