





84465 Horse Canyon Spring-

BLM is protesting this application on the following grounds:

There is no water available for appropriation at the source. BLM is 1/3 owner of vested water right V04651 and claims a PWR107 federally reserved right. The BLM acquired Horse Canyon Spring and all associated improvements in 2010 including other springs and improvements in the watershed, namely in the NW ¼ of section 34 and SW ¼ of section 35. The water is available for use by the permittee and provides water for livestock grazing, domestic uses associated with recreation, and provisions for wildlife and riparian vegetation.

Currently Horse Canyon Spring feeds a trough located approximately 2.75 miles from the spring in section 23. While the applicant has grazing permits, the applicant is applying to use the water outside of the permitted use of the pasture. The applicant is permitted for livestock from 9/1 to 10/30 for the pasture that Horse Canyon and all its improvements are located in, however, the applicant is applying for use from 3/1 to 11/30. Therefore the applicant is applying to use water for 7.5 months during which they are not permitted to use the pasture for grazing. Through BLMs vested water right, the applicant has full use of water for grazing during their permitted use period.
