BLM is protesting this application on the following grounds:

There is no water available for appropriation at the source. BLM holds vested water right V04654 and claims a PWR 107 federally reserved right which provides water for livestock grazing, domestic uses associated with recreation, and provisions for wildlife and riparian vegetation.

The BLM acquired CCC Spring and all associated improvements in 2010.

While applicant has grazing permits, the applicant is applying to use water outside of the permitted use on the allotment. Applicant is applying for use from 3/1 to 11/30. Applicant is only permitted within the specific pastures that CCC Spring and its associated improvements are located in from 7/15 to 9/15. The applicant is applying to use water for 7 months during which they are not permitted to use the pasture for grazing. Through the BLM vested water right and PWR 107 claim, the applicant has full use of water for grazing during their permitted use period.
