

County, State of Nevada, for the following reasons and on the following grounds, to wit:

Requests for additional groundwater to be pumped in an area already identified as a "high risk" area is alarming. Additional pumping on this site would not be sound beneficial use to neighbors in an ongoing drought of 4 yrs. Since this is the first year previously sold surface and groundwater has not been used on the majority of Turf Farm property, it would be detrimental to the water supply to now allow such transfers. Property owners bordering the Turf Farm can verify 5 wells that have been replaced or worked on in the current drought (both domestic & irrig.). At the rate of decrease of the water table in this area, no changes should be made as all try to conserve. Also within a short distance of the property (and in the same risk area) 9 other wells have been replaced or will need deepened and some properties have been vacated. The history of over use of groundwaters by the Turf Farm is also a major concern. If we are to maintain a balance of water in this community for all, we must rely on the the system of control available. Please see attached sheet of others concerned.

THEREFORE the Protestant requests that the application be denied due to the current and known conditions of the drought
