

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATIONS 13655 AND 13656)
FILED BY BOZARTH AND RUDNICK AND WHICH WERE : RULING
PROTESTED BY JAMES M. DANIELS.)

Application 13655 was filed by Bozarth and Rudnick on March 14, 1951 for the waters of Stewart No. 1 Spring for stock-watering purposes. The location of the point of diversion is within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 12, T. 6 S., R. 40 E. This application was protested by James M. Daniels on June 28, 1951.

Application 13656 was filed by Bozarth and Rudnick on March 14, 1951 for the waters of Stewart No. 2 Spring for stock-watering purposes. The location of the point of diversion is within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 1, T. 6 S., R. 40 E. This application was protested by James M. Daniels on June 28, 1951.

RULING

The protests of James M. Daniels to the granting of permits under Applications 13655 and 13656 are overruled on the grounds that the proposed stockwatering facilities are within the Grazing Lease of Bozarth and Rudnick and are outside of any area leased to James M. Daniels.

A permit will be issued under each application upon receipt of the statutory fee.
