

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATIONS NOS.
17242 and 17243, FILED APRIL 15,
1957 BY LA VONNE E. CUSIC AND
EDDIE M. CUSIC, RESPECTIVELY, TO
APPROPRIATE WATER FROM UNDERGROUND
SOURCES FOR IRRIGATION PURPOSES IN
HUMBOLDT COUNTY, NEVADA.

RULING

General:

33A Applications Nos. 17242 and 17243 were filed in support of Desert Land Entries, Nevada 012280 and Nevada 012290.

On July 22, 1957 this office received a letter from the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management, with regard to the status of these land entries. The following is a quotation from a portion of said letter:

"Both entries, Nevada 012280 and Nevada 012290, have been closed on the Land Office records as of June 6, 1956 for failure to comply with the regulations and reinstatement of these entries is not possible as the lands have been allowed to Myrtle A. and Marvin W. Baldwin, Nevada 044131 and Nevada 044132".

RULING

Applications Nos. 17242 and 17243 are denied on grounds that the applicants do not have possession of the land to be irrigated and, therefore, can not place the water to beneficial use.
