

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATIONS NOS.
17074 AND 17169, FILED OCTOBER 23,
1956 AND FEBRUARY 1, 1957, RESPEC-
TIVELY, BY ARLIN DAVIDSON, TO
APPROPRIATE WATERS FROM WILLARD
CREEK IN WHITE PINE COUNTY. }

RULING

General:

Application No. 17074 was filed to appropriate 0.75 c.f.s. of the waters of Willard Creek, for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The period of use is from May 1 to October 1, of each year. A protest of the granting of this application was filed on February 14, 1957 by R. O. Heinbaugh, on grounds that it would impair the value of his existing water rights.

Application No. 17169 was filed on February 1, 1957 to appropriate 0.75 c.f.s. of the waters of Willard Creek, for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The period of use is from May 1 to October 1, of each year. No protest was filed to the granting of this application.

Opinion:

It is the opinion of this office that the waters of Willard Creek are fully appropriated during the irrigation season.

RULING

Protest to the granting of Application No. 17074 is herewith sustained and the application is denied on the grounds that it will impair the value of existing rights and be detrimental to the public welfare.

Application Number 17169 is herewith denied on grounds that it would impair the value of existing rights and would be detrimental to the public welfare.
