

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION NO. 17192,  
FILED BY JOHN, DON AND CLINN LAMB, ON  
FEBRUARY 22, 1957, TO APPROPRIATE UNDER-  
GROUND WATER FOR MILLING AND DOMESTIC  
PURPOSES, IN PERSHING COUNTY, NEVADA.

RULING

General:

70 Application No. 17093 was filed to appropriate 1.0 c.f.s. of underground water, within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 31, T. 29 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B.&M. A protest to the granting of said application was filed on July 15, 1957, by the City of Lovelock, on grounds that its granting would seriously interfere with the protestant's underground water rights in the vicinity of the proposed application. From an investigation by this office, it was found that the proposed point of diversion is located in an area where there will be little or no interference with existing underground water rights.

RULING

The protest to the granting of Application No. 17192 is herewith overruled, on grounds that its granting will not impair the value of existing rights or be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare.
