RULING

General:

A protest to the granting of this application was filed on December 31, 1956, by Jim Daniels, on grounds that the waters are in protestant's grazing area by virtue of lease from the United States Bureau of Land Management.

RULING

The protest to the granting of Application No. 16957 is herewith overruled on grounds that the granting thereof will not interfere with any existing water right of the protestant.

A permit will be issued under Application No. 16957 upon receipt of the statutory permit fee. If a permit is granted it will not imply a right to the use of the Federal range by the applicant.
