

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION NO.
18180, FILED JULY 31, 1959 BY MRS.
CORDELIA ASHBY TO APPROPRIATE THE
WATER OF AN UNDERGROUND SOURCE FOR
IRRIGATION AND DOMESTIC PURPOSES,
IN EUREKA COUNTY, NEVADA.

RULING

General:

Application No. 18180 was filed in support of Desert Land Application Nev.-050648. On March 7, 1960 we were notified by the Bureau of Land Management, Reno, Nevada, that the land entry was cancelled by relinquishment on January 5, 1959. As of the date of this ruling, the applicant does not have control of the land on which she plans to place the water to beneficial use.

RULING

Application No. 18180 is hereby denied on grounds that the applicant does not have control of the land on which she plans to place the water to beneficial use and that its granting would be detrimental to the public welfare.
